Greetings from Romania! God has blessed in many ways since our last letter. We baptized three people in April. We have others who should be baptized so please pray for them to take this important step. We have installed four inch thick Styrofoam insulation on the exterior walls of the building. We also have the electricity hooked up! Another blessing is that the road in front of our property was paved. We recently received funds that will enable us to finish everything we have left to do on the building! We want to thank everyone who has given towards the building project! I am amazed at how God has provided for this building through your generosity. I praise God for His provision through you! I am glad to be able to say that we should not be in need of any more funds to be given for the building.

We will now be able to start focusing and investing more in the ministry itself. We have recently started an additional ministry for the children in Sotanga and we had 32 children and three mothers attend this past Saturday. We want to expand the use of the building and the land that we have. We want to build playground equipment to give the kids a safe place to play. There is no park in Sotanga.

The building and ministry in Targoviste is continuing. We have had a few visitors. As always pray for souls to be saved and for spiritual growth in both works. Our Landlady that prayed to receive Christ a few months ago has said that she wants to make some improvements to the building that will make it more comfortable and easier to heat and less noise interference from outside.

We recently had the opportunity to witness to two mothers that are Orthodox Christians. They are both sick and may not have many months left. It can be difficult for them to understand that their church or their religion cannot save them. Their only hope is to look to Jesus and trust Him as their Savior! Please pray for God to open their eyes.

The U.S. dollar has weakened compared to where it was a couple of months ago but it is still at a good rate of 4.04 Lei to the dollar. More good news on the economic front is that Romania has lowered their TVA or sales tax to 9% on food items down from 24%. These are even more reasons to be grateful to God! We want to thank each of you again for your prayerful support and sacrificial gifts that allow us to serve here on the field of Romania!

We look forward to what God will do in us and through us as we serve Him here in Romania. Thank you again for making this possible!
