Greetings to you in our Lord's name. By the grace of our Lord and with the help of your loving prayers, we are doing well in the ministry despite various challenges we face on the field. God is Faithful, as someone said, where God leads He also provides. He also gives us a great protection as we drive to the churches and villages on various meeting opportunities. We thank God for the vehicle God has given us although it is giving us some mechanical troubles lately. We've been using it since 2009 and put over 200,000 kilometers on it. The engine has been rebuilt twice so far; but the Lord is allowing us to travel safely despite all these troubles.

After almost two long months, we finally got some rain today. Many of our people are farmers, and depend on the rain for their crops. The rain has put great joy in their hearts. It is even a greater joy for us to see the faithfulness of God in encouraging us and providing all of our needs both in the ministry and also in our personal family lives. We had a problem with our banks in transferring funds to us for over two months. But God by His grace has been so faithful and helped us in this difficult time. Many thanks to our IBM business office staff for their many hours of toil and labor in helping us come out of this problem.

Shiloh Baptist Bible College ministry is doing well. We started offering Master of Divinity classes this year. We have four students enrolled in the Masters Program. We were able to paint all the rooms both interior and exterior, and fix cupboards in the kitchen and in the guest rooms. We also have built a watchman's room near the main gate. We need to paint the room and security wall. We will need about \$500 for painting. We are also working on our office room. We need \$500 for the needed partitions, and office furniture. I appreciate your prayers for these needs.

God is been so faithful in helping us with the church constructions too. The church in Rakasipet is almost completed. They are currently working on the interior. Doors and window shades need to be put up. The flooring is almost completed. The church building in Karakkayala Gudem will have its roof by next week. The church constructions in Narsingi, Narsampally, Thanda and SV Puram are also seeing some developments. These buildings

will need about \$10,000 each to complete the basic structure and begin services.
