Greetings from Romania! We are very grateful to each of you who prayerfully support the Lord's ministry here in Romania. The weather and the scenery have turned to spring. The blossoms on our fruit trees have been exceptionally numerous and beautiful.

Since our last prayer letter much has happened. We have purchased three orders of tracts in the last four months. Our latest order is for Easter which will be on May first for us here in Romania. We will be dividing the 1,100 tracts between the three Churches. Since our last letter we have lent a helping hand to another missionary who has a work in Bucharest. We are sending some people out of the church in Ploiesti to help while the missionary is in the States on a medical furlough for their young son (Joey).

Sally and I had the opportunity to visit a woman in Ploiesti and she prayed to receive Christ as her Savior. We recently visited a couple who had received a tract that we had left in a restaurant. The woman was already saved but we led her husband to Christ! We were so grateful to God for using us to point these people to Christ! Please pray for Grigore in Targoviste and Mariana in Ploiesti.

The Church in Targoviste has been very low in attendance. We are changing the schedule of services and we will be more involved with Bro. Gica with evangelizing the city together. We have lost two people from the same family who are both working out of the country. One is in Italy and the other is in Germany.

In Sotanga we have a group that is helping us with a special children's program. They are meeting on Saturdays and there will be an Easter program on the last Saturday in April. Please pray with us that some of these Children's parents will come and hear the Gospel.

Please pray for Anitsa who is a young woman and mother of two young daughters (Antonio and Maya). Antonia has a problem with her eyes (cross-eyed) Anitsa has recently moved back to live with her family in Sotanga. She had been living in an abusive relationship. She is saved but it is a difficult situation because four of them share a small room and they have a very poor diet. Her Grandmother Margareta has been visiting some of our services. Please pray for Margareta's salvation.

Thank you again for your prayers and financial support of the Lord's ministry here! Please pray for wisdom, strength and safety as we serve the Lord Jesus here in Romania.
