Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings from Romania! Thank you for your prayerful support of the Lord's ministry here in Romania. The weather has changed to summer with mostly hot weather but with occasional cooling periods which are a welcome relief.

Since our last letter we have had unexpected challenges and blessings. One of the challenges was to do with our Ford van. I took it in to the repair shop because the motor was making some noise. They replaced the clutch, the front shocks, the muffler and the thermostat. The next day I took the van over a very uneven road and one of the wheels started making noise so I took the van back to the shop. Driving here in Romania is dangerous because of the poor condition of many of the roads. It is also dangerous because of the many bad drivers which we share these roads with. Another reason is because of the fact that many people who have cars do not see the need to keep their cars in good mechanical condition. Praise the Lord that He has kept us safe so far. Because of the repairs on the van it really took away from some of our ministry funds which limits our ministry opportunities.

One of the blessings that we had was that one of our supporting Churches gave us funds to buy some needed items for the Church in Ploiesti. Just yesterday we installed two air conditioners and a video projector. We are very grateful to God and each of our supporting Churches for your faithful support and generous gifts! Another blessing was that we have had a young man (15) visiting the Church in Sotanga and he recently came up to me after a service and asked how he could be saved. What a joy to lead him to Jesus. Please pray for Adelin. He has been coming faithfully to every service.

Please continue to pray for Grigore in Targoviste and Mariana in Ploiesti. Please pray that God would open the door for us to visit and disciple these two new converts.

In Targoviste we have moved the services, temporarily, to our house in Vacaresti . We are waiting on the new location to be renovated. Please pray for the new location to be available soon.

In Sotanga the Easter program went well. Thank you for praying and please continue to pray for the children's ministry in Sotanga, Ploiesti and Bucharest.

Please pray for Anitsa, the young woman who I had mentioned in our last letter, who had recently returned to Sotanga from an abusive relationship. She has since returned into that abusive relationship in order to stay close to her two small daughters.

Thank you again for your prayers and financial support of the Lord's ministry here! Please pray for wisdom, strength and safety as we serve the Lord Jesus here in Romania.
