We have been so busy these past few months! We have been blessed with 5 groups of visitors since May. The last one being a young Mexican missionary who hopes to return the Montevideo within two years. José Noriega and his bride to be, Paloma, will be starting deputation in 2017. We are excited to have more missionaries in the Montevideo area!

Larry is busy eight hours a week teaching Sunday School, a Bible institute class, and two college classes. Of course the preparation time is extra. He also preaches every other week, leads the music, and is now involved with directing our Christmas program. His weekly errands downtown also consume a large portion of his days. Kathryn keeps busy working around and in the house, teaching Sunday School and Junior church, and teaching an English class. Of course she still finds time to do some baking which keeps everyone happy! Linda continues her studies at IBC in Arizona.

FEBU is earnestly looking for its own building to have classrooms and dorm rooms for future students. Please keep this in prayer as you pray for the college. Also, pray for Larry as he will be teaching new classes next year. These classes take a lot of preparation time as he needs to compile most of the material himself. Larry is enjoying his time with the students. His heart has always been for teaching, and God has blessed in allowing him to be a part of FEBU.

We are still waiting for our permanent visas. Larry had to turn in more paperwork this week. We have spent more than a year working on the paperwork and waiting for the decision. It's in the Lord's hands, so we just have to wait!

Healthwise, we are fine with the exception of Larry's right arm. The pain started two months ago in his elbow and then moved into his shoulder. The Dr. has ordered an x-ray for Oct. 7th. Larry has been trying to rest his arm, but with directing music, writing, typing, and driving a stick shift car in stop and go traffic, it doesn't get a chance to rest and heal. Please pray for his right arm!

Pastor Martín celebrated his 88th birthday in July, and his wife, Agavni, turned 84 in August. Muriel, the 87 year-old missionary who we serve with, fell in July and had surgery on her femur. After weeks of rest and recuperation, she is now walking with her walker and doing quite well. Please continue to pray for these special people.
